Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 872 establishes a state school security director within the State Department of Education (NDE). The director is to collect safety and security plans from each school district, recommend minimum standards for school security, conduct an assessment of the security of each public school building, identify deficiencies in school security, establish a security awareness and preparedness training program for school staff and establish model programs for students and parents to address causes for violent attacks on schools. The State Board of Education may adopt rules and regulations establishing minimum school security standards on or before July 1, 2015.

NDE requested funds to hire a School Safety Education Specialist in its supplemental budget request for FY2013-14 and FY2014-15. The department requested \$93,532 of general funds each fiscal year for the position. The narrative accompanying the request described most of the activities required by the bill. However, the requirement to conduct an assessment of the security of each public school building in the state by January 1, 2016 will likely increase the amount of transportation for the security director beyond that contemplated in the NDE request. It is assumed an additional \$3,000 of general funds will be required for travel expenses in FY15 and FY16. It is also assumed that the assessment of the security of each public school building will not necessarily be on site for the estimated 1,000 public school buildings in the state.

The bill also provides that the school security director may provide services to private schools for a fee which shall not exceed the cost of providing the services. Any fee revenue is projected to be minimal and can be deposited in the Department of Education Cash Fund to be used for school safety related activities.
