Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 944 provides intent language for the Legislature to appropriate \$400,000 of general funds in FY2014-15 and \$400,000 of general funds in FY2015-16 to the State Department of Education (NDE) to expand the Nurturing Healthy Behaviors program and contract with partner organizations for early childhood consultation services. The services are to be available to child care centers, preschool programs and elementary schools to serve children from birth to eight years of age. The bill prioritizes the distribution of funds to the expansion of early childhood programs in areas of the state underserved by mental health providers and where there are high numbers of at-risk children.

NDE indicates there will be minimal expenditures by existing staff to create an RFP and manage the grant making process in FY15. Monitoring of the grant will be done by staff in FY16. It is assumed NDE can handle the responsibilities with existing staff and resources of the agency. The fiscal impact of the bill is assumed to be \$400,000 of general funds in FY15 and in FY16 for the Nurturing Healthy Behaviors program, per the intent language in the bill.

COMMENTS: If the Legislature were to appropriate \$400,000 General Funds in each of FY 2014-15 and FY 2015-16 to accommodate the intent language in LB 944, then the Department's estimate of \$4,300 in FY 2014-15 and \$1,713 in FY 2014-15 for additional operations costs appears reasonable. The Department's fiscal note incorrectly accounts for the \$400,000 as Cash Funds; the bill intends the use of General Funds.

A small amount is being budgeted for supplies needed to complete the RFP in year one. A small amount is also being budgeted to travel for monitoring the grant in both years No provision for NDE to access any of the allocation was made in the bill.
