Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 272 creates a voluntary veterans preference in private employment.

The bill would allow a private employer to establish a policy that prefers veterans for hiring and promotion over another equally qualified applicant or employee.

The policy is to be in writing, the employer is to notify the Commissioner of Labor of the policy, and having such a policy in place shall not be considered a violation of any state or local equal employment opportunity law.

A veteran desiring to use the preference shall provide the employer with the necessary documentation to prove their status. This policy would also apply to the spouse of a veteran with a 100% permanent disability, as determined by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs.

The Department of Labor is to maintain a registry of private employers who have implemented a veterans preference policy.

The Department of Labor and the Equal Opportunity Commission have both indicated no fiscal impact as a result of LB 272.

We agree with both agencies on the fiscal impact of LB 272.
