This bill creates the Health Care Transformation Act. A Health Care Transformation Advisory Committee will develop recommendations for implementing changes to the health care delivery system and recommendations on health care policy, quality metrics and technology. The advisory committee is authorized to hire a coordinator, consultants, evaluators and other personnel to assist the committee. The committee will issue an initial report on or before December 15, 2015 and a final report by December 15, 2016.

The Department of Health and Human Services will need a Health Program Manager and administrative assistant. Staff and operating costs would be \$132,582 in FY 16 and FY 17. Contracts for consultants and/or evaluators are estimated to cost \$100,000.
