Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

This bill would eliminate certain mandatory minimum penalties.

Eliminating mandatory minimum penalties could reduce the state prison inmate population because inmates would not have to serve a mandatory minimum sentence before being able to earn good time. This could result in offenders be paroled or released earlier.

The Department of Correctional Services (DCS) estimates that inmates could reach their parole eligibility dates and tentative release dates approximately 2.3 years sooner than under current law. This could result in a savings of \$12,491 in FY16 and \$129,225 in FY17. See the attached DCS response for details.

The FY14 per diem for an individual inmate was \$7,124 per year. This is the cost for food, medical care, inmate wages, clothing, cleaning supplies, food service supplies, cell and dorm supplies, other supplies, and transportation.

As of December 31, 2014, the inmate population was 159% of design capacity. On December 31, 2013, the inmate population was 153% of design capacity.

The Department of Health and Human Services estimates no fiscal impact from this bill.
