LB 279 allows a Limited Liability Corporation, Nonprofit Corporation, a Corporation, and a Limited Cooperative Association to be reinstated after more than five years following administrative dissolution. A fee for such reinstatement is required.

The Secretary of State estimates approximately 15 such reinstatement applications per year. This would result in revenue for the General Fund in the amount of \$5,000 and to the Corporations Cash Fund in the amount of \$2,500.

A one-time cost for system programming is estimated to be \$3,800. These estimates appear to be reasonable.

Explanation of Estimate:

LB 279 provides a mechanism for Limited Liability Corporations, Nonprofit Corporations, Corporations, and Limited Cooperative Associations to reinstate more than five years following administrative dissolution by filing the applicable documentation and paying an additional late reinstatement fee of \$500. It is anticipated that system programming associated with the filing and late filing fee will total \$3,800. It is estimated that approximately 15 entities per year will reinstate pursuant to this legislation, which will result in additional revenue of \$7,500 to the State with \$5,000 going to the general fund and \$2,500 going to the corporations cash fund on an annual basis.
