LB 535 allows the Public Service Commission to regulate depth requirements for underground natural gas pipeline and major oil pipeline facilities that are located in two or more counties.

Since the bill is permissive and not mandatory, it could be argued that there is no required effort nor cost associated with the bill's provisions.

If the PSC does provide depth requirements by rule and regulation, the cost would also be minimal.

The PSC notes that if the intent of the bill is to require the Commission to enforce the depth requirements, there would likely be a fiscal impact. That cannot be determined without further clarification.
