Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 477 changes provisions relating to school districts which maintain the only public high school in a county. The bill allows these districts to continue to operate a high school with 15 to 24 students, in grades 9 through 12, if a plan is submitted to show a broad-based curriculum as determined by the State Committee for the Reorganization of School Districts and if a majority of voters approve a ballot issue to continue the high school. If the ballot issue fails, the state committee is to dissolve the district and transfer land to contiguous school districts.

Currently, there are perhaps less than twelve school districts that may be impacted by the bill in the near future, depending upon membership. The bill has a fiscal impact for school districts which may be allowed to continue operation pursuant to the bill and contiguous districts that would be involved in a reorganization. In the absence of the bill, there may be dissolutions of districts which impacts the revenue and expenditures of school districts involved in reorganizations. No fiscal impact can be determined for school districts.

The bill may only minimally impact the workload of the State Committee for the Reorganization of School Districts. Any increased workload can be handled with existing resources.
