LB 20 would have no fiscal impact to state agencies.

LB 20 would amend requirements for public access to natural resources district (NRD) water projects. Current law states that public recreational access shall not be required when the portion of total project costs paid by the NRD with public funds does not exceed 25%. LB 20 would amend the percentage of public funding that would necessitate public access from the current 25% to 5%. This provision would require that in the future, more projects be built with designated access roads for public recreational users. The overall cost of road construction would be factored into the total project cost, which would vary on a case-by-case basis and can not be estimated at this time.
