This bill establishes a task force to examine a state policy regarding the use of prescription psychotropic drugs for state wards. The task force shall consist of no more than 12 members. The staff of the legislature's Health and Human Services Committee will staff the task force. The task force may include lay, professional, organizational and governmental representatives. The task force will report to the legislature no later than January 1, 2008. The task force is sunset on the same date.

Task force members would be eligible for reimbursement for travel. The cost is unknown since the number of task force members is not defined and the number of meetings is also unknown. The General Fund cost could be very minimal to several thousand dollars depending on the number of members, the area of the state where the appointees reside and the number of meetings of the task force.
