LB 309 provides for permanently issued handicapped or disabled parking permits to be valid for six years rather than three years beginning on January 1, 2008. Applicants for permits on or after that date may also request the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) to adjust the expiration date of the permit to match the year in which the applicant's handicapped or disabled license plates will be reissued.

DMV indicates there will need to be changes made to the computer program used to issue handicapped permits. The department estimates a one-time contracted programming expense of \$13,500 of cash funds in 2007-08.
