LB 638 repeals obsolete language in the Nebraska Bingo Act, Nebraska Pickle Card Lottery Act, and the Nebraska Lottery and Raffle Act relating to annual licensing of nonprofit organizations, businesses, and individuals. The fee for licenses doubles, but all licenses would be issued on a biennial basis.

Also, LB 638 authorizes the Department of Revenue Investigative Services Division to perform investigative and enforcement activities relating to illegal gambling devices in Nebraska concurrently with the Nebraska State Patrol's Alcohol and Tobacco Enforcement Division.

As amended, LB 638 would extend the current distribution of proceeds from Lottery ticket sales until January, 2009.

As amended, LB 638 would change the purchase amount for the Nebraska Lottery which is subject to the approval of the Tax Commissioner. The current amount is \$15,000, and the bill proposes changing the amount to \$25,000.

There appears to be no net material fiscal impact associated with this bill.
