Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

This bill states the intent to appropriate \$5,000,000 to the Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs). The distribution is as follows: \$200,000 for each of the seven FQHCs to expand capacity; \$1.2 million distributed proportionately to the FQHCs based on the total number of patients served in the previous year to serve Nebraskans on waiting lists or subject to delays in receiving services at health centers and \$2.4 million distributed proportionately to the FQHCs based on the total number of patients served in the previous year.

Explanation of Estimate:

LB 923 appropriates \$5,000,000 to be divided between the seven federally qualified health centers in Nebraska. \$1,400,000 will be shared equally with \$200,000 going to each health center. \$1,200,000 will be divided proportionally between the health centers based on the number of patients served in the previous year. A final \$2,400,000 will be divided between the health centers based on the previous year's number of uninsured as reported through the uniform data system of the Health Resources and Services Administration of the United States Department of Health and Human Services.
