Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

This bill establishes the Palliative Care Consumer and Professional Information and Education Program. The nine-member Palliative Care and Quality of Life Advisory Council is created. By January 1, 2017, the Council shall assist each health care facility and health care service establish a system for identifying patients or residents who could benefit from hospice or palliative care and provide information about and facilitate access to appropriate care or services.

The Department of Health and Human Services estimates the cost to reimburse council members at \$2,388 annually. A temporary worker would be hired to assist the council. The cost would be \$4,970 annually.

Explanation of Estimate:

LB 1043 would require the Department of Health and Human Services to 1) establish the Palliative Care Consumer and Professional Information and Education Program; and 2) consult with a governor-appointed Palliative Care and Quality of Life Advisory Council created by the bill. The Department would be required to include information regarding the program on its website, provide a place and time for the council to meet and provide staffing assistance as necessary for the council meetings which must be held twice each calendar year.

To implement the provisions of LB 1043, the Department would utilize temporary staff at a costs of \$4,970 per year (350 hours at \$14.20 per hour) to gather and update the information regarding the program on its web site and support the work of the Council. In addition, the Department estimates the cost of meals, lodging and mileage for the Palliative Care and Quality of Life Advisory Council of \$2,388 per year.
