Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 75 changes provisions related to restoring voting rights for convicted felons who have satisfactorily completed the conditions to their probation by removing the current twenty-four month waiting period.

The Secretary of State will need to re-code their system to remove the twenty-four month waiting period reference. They estimate the costs of reprogramming to be \$1,050.

There is no basis to disagree with this estimate.
