LB 216 would adopt the Redistricting Act. The bill proposes process and procedures for conducting the decennial redistricting. This includes creation of the Independent Redistricting Citizen’s Advisory Commission for the purpose of assisting the Legislature in the process of redistricting in 2021.

The bill would have no fiscal impact from what otherwise would occur in a redistricting process except for reimbursement of actual expenses of the advisory commission as created in Section 22. With a seven member commission and assuming that the commission meets 8 times and holds four public hearings around the state, expenses are estimated at approximately \$18,000. This can vary depending on the residence location of members for purposes of lodging and mileage costs. Note that these expenses would not occur until the next redistricting process in 2021.

Explanation of Estimate:

LB216 would adopt the Redistricting Act. The bill proposes process and procedures for conducting the decennial redistricting. This includes creation of the Independent Redistricting Citizen’s Advisory Commission for the purpose of assisting the Legislature in the process of redistricting in 2021.

The bill would have no fiscal impact from what otherwise would occur in a redistricting process except for reimbursement of actual expenses of the Advisory Commission. Assuming a seven (7) member commission (Section 22) meets eight (8) times and holds at least four (4) public hearings in different geographic regions of the State, expenses are estimated at approximately \$18,000. Note that these expenses would not occur until the next redistricting process in 2021.
