**Explanation of Estimate:**

The proposed legislation would establish the Community Solar Energy Economic Development Act. For purposes of the Act, communities would be encouraged to apply to the Nebraska Environmental Trust Board for a grant to support a qualified solar project. The grant project funding would not exceed twenty-five percent of the project cost and would be subject to ranking and approval processes established by the Trust.

Since no specific funding requirements are imposed outside of the normal granting process, no fiscal impact is anticipated.
