LB 882 pertains to the qualification of indigent persons who have received mental health board ordered inpatient or outpatient treatment to receive prescription medicine upon discharge from a treatment facility. The cost of the medicine is paid by the Department of Health and Human Services. The bill does not appear to have any fiscal impact. The bill clarifies and places in statute existing practices and procedures regarding the provision of prescription medicine for indigent persons.
