LB 919 pertains to fees paid for fleets of apportionable vehicles. The bill provides that applications for refunds of fees or credits from Nebraska-based fleet owners who take an apportionable vehicle out of service must be made within the registration period. The bill also changes the date upon which a registration fee is to be charged when a fleet vehicle is placed into service. The Department of Motor Vehicles indicates there may be a minimal unknown increase in cash fund revenue pursuant to the bill.
