This bill would create degrees of offenses of assault on an emergency services provider or a health care provider.

The Department of Correctional Services (DCS) states that the fiscal impact of this bill is not determinable but is assumed to be minimal. DCS further states that it is unknown how many individuals would be sentenced for assault on an emergency services provider or health care provider, but it is anticipated that less than 5% of the admissions would be for this offense. In CY2006 there were 115 admissions to DCS for Assault in the 1st or 2nd degree, and in CY2007 there were 102 admissions.
