**Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.**

LB 671 changes the enforcement of provisions regarding motor vehicles. The bill provides that violations of provisional operator permit requirements are changed from secondary to primary offenses. The bill also provides that violations against holders of learner's permits, school permits, or commercial vehicle operator licenses who use an interactive wireless communication device while operating a motor vehicle will be considered to be primary rather than secondary offenses.

Persons can be cited for a primary offense if they do not use seatbelts for children and holders of provisional or school operator's permits can be cited for a primary offense if seatbelts are not used by all occupants. LB 671 requires all occupants of motor vehicles to wear seatbelts. Current law requires front-seat occupants only. School bus operators are also prohibited from using any type of interactive wireless communication device.

Revenue: The bill should result in an increase in persons who are guilty of traffic infractions since the enforcement of certain provisions are changed to be primary offenses rather than secondary actions. The amount of increased revenue from fines is not able to be determined. Any increase in fine revenue will accrue to the county or local entity where the fine is imposed to be used by public schools.

Expenditures: The State Department of Education indicates that a rule pertaining to school bus drivers will need to be revised, if LB 671 passes. It is assumed the department can handle any costs or workload increase related to rule revisions with existing staff and resources.

**Explanation of Estimate:**

The section of this bill affecting the Department relates to prohibiting the use of interactive wireless communication devices by school bus operators. This bill would require only school bus operators to pull over the school bus before using a wireless communication device in any way to communicate.

The Department currently has a regulation in Pupil Transportation Rule 91 (Section 005.71) that bans the use of wireless communication devices for reading, writing, and sending texts by drivers of all pupil transportation vehicles while the vehicle is in motion. LB671 would add safety measures to pupil transportation because it prohibits the use of interactive wireless communication devices for any purpose while the vehicle is in motion. LB 671 only restricts wireless access for buses so small pupil transportation vehicles (cars or small vans) would be exempt from this requirement.

If this bill would pass, Rule 91 would need to be revised to match statute. The cost to print hearing drafts, publish required hearing notices and hold a hearing would be approximately \$800.
