LB 1033 changes provisions of the Nebraska Advantage Rural Development Act.

The bill expands the areas to which the program reaches so the lowest level could be a village or city regardless of the county. The Department of Revenue provides the example of Lancaster County being currently ineligible for Advantage Rural, expect for livestock modernization. Under LB 1033, an Advantage Rural project could be done in Bennett (in Lancaster County) with only two employees.

The bill also adds former enterprise areas to the current enterprise areas.

While the reach of the program is expanded, the overall limits for credits are not changed.

Since the available funds are not increased, there is no fiscal impact to the state.
