LB1056 would adopt the First Class City Merger Act. The act prescribes a process under which any two or more contiguous and adjacent cities of the first class would be authorized to merge. While economies might be achieved through such authorized mergers by the limited number of municipalities to which the provisions of the bill would apparently apply, provisions of the bill do not compel such mergers. Any related impacts would apparently be dependent upon indeterminate future actions of the city councils and electorates of affected municipalities under authority granted by the bill.
