LB 724 would reduce the application fee under the Remedial Action Plan Monitoring Act from \$5,000 to \$2,000 and would reduce the deposit fee from \$5,000 to \$3,000. The fees are deposited in the Remedial Action Plan Monitoring Act Cash Fund and are used to offset the expenses of the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ). Fees are paid and activities undertaken only if an entity applies to have DEQ monitor voluntary remedial action plans. Because DEQ notes that participation in the program has been minimal in recent years, it is estimated that the reduction in application and deposit fees would not have a substantial impact in program revenue or expenditures.
