LB726 would allow the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) to provide financial assistance to municipalities with a population of less than 10,000 inhabitants for completion various engineering and research projects relating to compliance with the Clean Water Act. In addition, the annual expenditures of DEQ would be based on a portion of revenue received from administrative fees in the prior fiscal year and would not be capped at \$500,000. There is no basis to disagree with the DEQ estimate that an additional \$200,000 to \$250,000 in cash funds could be spent annually for this purpose. It is estimated that the amount annual cash fund revenue is adequate to absorb additional expenditures.
