LB 725 would allow the Department of Environmental Quality to make grants from the Waste Reduction and Recycling Incentive Cash Fund to cities of the second class, villages and counties with a population of 5,000 or fewer inhabitants for the purpose of deconstruction of abandoned buildings, provided that the recyclable content of the buildings are processed for recycling. The addition of this provision would expand the potential use of the Waste Reduction and Recyling Incentive Cash Fund, but would not impact total fund expenditures.
