LB 764 would amend the Nebraska Pure Food Act to add a requirement for vendors preparing food in a kitchen that is not subject to regulation and inspection by a regulatory authority. It would also place limitations upon the delivery of such products sold via the internet.

There is no basis to disagree with the Department of Agriculture's assessment that LB 764 would have a minimal impact upon the agency.

Explanation of Estimate:

This proposed bill will exempt certain operations in the Nebraska Pure Food Act from the definition of a food establishment. It would allow people to sell food prepared in their home directly to the public provided specified conditions are met. There are also restrictions on the use of internet for sales. A limited number of current licensee's will no longer be required to pay licensing fees resulting in fewer inspections conducted by NDA. The Department will be responsible for ensuring compliance with the exemption as defined in LB 764. This bill will have minimal fiscal impact on the Department.
