LB 893 would amend the Dog and Cat Purchase Protection Act to place new requirements upon pet shops. Pet shop owners would be prohibited from selling a pet animal unless the animal was obtained from an animal control facility, animal shelter, or animal rescue. Pet shops would be required to keep records and provide information regarding each animal's source facility, and to keep records regarding the animals for at least one year after the date of sale. Records would be available for inspection by the Department of Agriculture.

There is no basis to disagree with the Department of Agriculture that there would be a minimal fiscal impact to agency to carry out the provisions of LB 893.
