Nebraska National Guard members currently have ten years from the date of their initial membership to take advantage of the 75% tuition credit program. Under LB 746, if a member is unable to complete his or her course of study within the ten year period due to deployment on federal or state active duty status for not less than 120 days, the Adjutant General may extend the entitlement period equal to the length of the deployment (not to exceed five years).

By extending the eligibility time period there will be additional tuition credits approved for some members who were deployed on active duty. It is expected that the additional cost of the credits allowed under LB 746 will be minimal and able to be absorbed within the current General Fund appropriation for tuition credits.
