Sec. 13-2203 currently authorizes the governing body of various local governments, as defined in Sec. 13-2202 (3), to approve expenditure of public funds for nonalcoholic beverages and meals provided at one recognition dinner each year held for elected and appointed officials, employees, or volunteers of the local government. The maximum cost per person for such a dinner is currently limited to $\$ 25$. LB1036 would increase the authorized maximum cost per person to $\$ 50$. Related expenditures by local governments could increase beyond the current statutory limitation under provisions of LB1036; however, such increases would be dependent upon actions of related governing bodies to approve future expenditures in excess of the existing cost limitation.
