Current statute imposes a maximum speed limit of 60 mph on any portion of a freeway located in Douglas County. LB 35 would increase this maximum speed limit to 65 mph. The estimated cost to the Department of Roads to change speed limit signs is \$2,000.

With the adoption of the emergency clause, the \$2,000 expenditure for sign replacement could occur as early as FY2006-07.
