LB 829 provides the Public Service Commission with authority to determine whether rates for supported services provided for telehealth are fair and reasonable.

In addition, the bill strikes language that allowed for transfers from the Universal Service Fund to the General Fund under certain circumstances. That provision sunset on June 30, 2007.

Finally, the Commission is provided with the authority to determine whether rates for telecommunications-related services required for the provision of 911 service and enhanced wireless 911 service are fair and reasonable.

The Commission estimates no fiscal impact.
