LB734 deals with the Political Subdivisions Self-Funding Benefits Act. Current law provides that a city of the metropolitan class may provide an employee benefit plan without excess insurance if it obtains a determination from an independent actuary or insurer that excess insurance is not necessary to preserve the safety and soundness of the plan. LB734 would open up that provision to all political subdivisions. The savings to the political subdivision would be the cost of the excess insurance. Douglas County estimates an annual savings of \$70,000.
