LB 757 provides a refundable tax credit of \$500 for each individual who qualifies under the provisions of the Volunteer Emergency Responders Incentive Act. This bill has an operative date of January 1, 2008.

There are approximately 12,600 volunteer responders in the State of Nebraska. Of this total, it is estimated that most would qualify for the tax credit in the first year.

Assuming 100% qualification, the estimated revenue impact is as follows.
