This bill would rename the Sexual Predator Residency Restriction Act and provide for certain employment restrictions.

It appears that this bill will not have a fiscal impact. The Nebraska State Patrol (NSP) estimates no fiscal impact.

The Department of Correctional Services (DCS) states that DCS Adult Parole currently supervises between 12-20 parolees and Lifetime Sex Offenders who could be impacted by this bill. This could result in an increase in workload for the Parole Officers, but this increase could be absorbed and no additional staffing or funding will be required.
