LB 244 appears similar to legislation that became operative in 2018 that authorized mobile cosmetology. To date, no applications have been submitted to the Department for licensure under that legislation. The Department is aware of two instances of public requests for licensure as a mobile message therapist. As the current massage therapy license allows therapists to travel and practice therapy in customers' homes, the Department estimates demand for mobile message therapy licensure to be minimal. All inspections are expected to be completed with existing staff resources.
