LB 630 changes the student threshold used to determine when land may be set off from a Class II or III school district and attached to an accredited district that is contiguous to the land. Currently, there must be less than 60 students in grades nine through twelve in average daily membership for two consecutive school years in order for a freeholder to petition for transfer. The bill changes the student threshold to less than 50 students in average daily membership in grades nine through twelve for the four preceding school years.

The bill may result in fewer tracts of land being transferred between school districts. It is not possible to project any fiscal impact for the bill. The transfer of land between school districts changes the valuation of districts involved in transfers and possibly the students served by affected school districts which may impact the revenues and expenditures of affected schools.
