LB 731 provides for the issuance of a teaching certificate or permit to spouses of active members of the armed forces who are residing in the state, if the applicant has or has held a valid certificate or permit in another state within three years of application, and the requirements for a teaching certificate in the other state are comparable.

It is assumed there will be very few individuals who will apply for teacher certificates pursuant to the bill. So, there will be a minimal increase in cash fund revenue for the Certification Fund and the Professional Practices Fund from teacher certificate fees. The State Department of Education will have increased expenses in 2008-09 to revise a rule. It is assumed the revision can be accomplished with existing staff and resources of the department.
