This bill requires all owners of a swimming pool, unless exempt, to employ at least one certified operator; provides for the requirements for a certified operator and provides for fees for certificates of competency for operators. Swimming pools in a private residence are exempt. The effective date of the bill is July 1, 2009.

An additional Environmental Health Specialist would be needed. The cost would be approximately \$64,000 in FY 10. The costs would continue after the current biennium. Fees would need to be set at a level to generate the funds to cover additional costs.
