LB 1021 adds two new categories of eligibility for students to be qualified for the option enrollment program. A student may be enrolled in the option program if enrollment allows a student to continue current enrollment in a school district, or if enrollment allows a student to attend a district the student was previously attending as a resident student.

The changes may increase the number of students in the option enrollment program. It is assumed any increase in students will be minimal pursuant to the bill. An increase in the number of option students increases the amount of net option funding received by a school district.
