Starting with the 2021-22 school year, LB1001 would require that schools list a phone number for a national suicide prevention hotline, a local suicide prevention hotline, or a crisis text line on each new student identification card issued to students in middle or high school as defined by the district's school board.

Also starting with the 2021-22 school year, LB1001 would require that public postsecondary institutions list a phone number for a national suicide prevention hotline, a local suicide prevention hotline, or a crisis text line on each new student identification card issued.

EXPENDITURES:

The Nebraska State College System (NSCS) estimates expenditures of \$5,000 annually to produce the proposed identification cards while other Nebraska school districts/institutions estimate an unknown to minimal increase in expenditures for implementation. NSCS estimates \$20,000 to print new cards for all students, this bill states that each "New" student would get an identification card with the suicide prevention information on it so because of this the NSCS expenditure is not included above.

LB1001 would require that the Colleges include a suicide prevention hotline or crisis text line on each student identification card. The requirement would begin with the 2021-22 academic year. The NSCS estimates that the cost to print new cards for all students in July/August, 2021 would be \$20,000 for the System. For future years, the annual cost to print on the front and back of student information cards would result in an increase in ongoing expenditures of approximately \$5,000 per year for the System.
