The bill prohibits dismemberment abortions. It defines terms and provides for legal remedies for violations. An exception is an abortion performed due to a medical emergency. An accused person may request a hearing before the Board of Medicine and Surgery to determine if an abortion was performed due to a medical emergency. The board's finding are admissible in court.

Very few hearings are anticipated due to the small number of dilation and evacuation abortions that are performed in the State. Those would be handled with existing agency resources.

LB 814 establishes dismemberment abortion, as defined, as a criminal act in the State of Nebraska. The Department of Health and Human Services' Board of Medicine and Surgery must accommodate a request for a hearing as specified under the bill.

According to the Department of Health and Human Services statistics, there were 32 dilation and evacuation abortions performed in 2018. Also, there were five physicians reporting to the department. The agency estimates the likelihood of reported violations to be minimal.
