## **Explanation of Estimate:**

One additional staff person will be needed to manage the increased number of records in the Nebraska Early Childhood Professional Records System (NECPRS). If the intention is to use state general funds then the entire amount of the fiscal note will need to be appropriated and PSL to the Nebraska Department of Education (NDE) will need to be increased to cover the staff expense. If it is the intention of the Legislature that federal Child Care Development Funds that are sub-granted from the Department of Health and Human Services to the NDE are to be used, then only PSL will need to be increased.

The calculations below include the salary and benefits for a staff person as well as operating expenses and travel.

Decrease funds needed for the second year assume that the first year includes one-time expenditures for a computer and appropriate software.

Since we are unsure if general funds or federal funds will be used to pay for the additional cost the amount was not included above.
