LB 1170 allows the Attorney General, a political subdivision, or a citizen of the state to bring an action against an employer who knowingly or recklessly recruited or employed illegal immigrants for recovery costs related to public services, including but not limited to public education costs, health care costs, and public assistance programs.

The Attorney General estimates no fiscal impact. It appears that any additional workload issues related to the bill's provisions could be addressed with currently budgeted resources.
