LB 1171 would establish the Agricultural Commodities Protection Act. LB 1171 states that an ethanol producer shall not refuse to sell ethanol to any motor fuel manufacturer, distributor, marketer or retailer. No state agency would be designated to enforce the act ; individuals would be allowed to bring actions for damages and injunctive relief as a result of the violation of the Act. It is estimated that the fiscal impact to state agencies would be minimal in nature.
