Explanation of Estimate:

LB 259 would allow public safety officers to file a civil action against any person, group of persons, organizations, corporations, or the head of an organization or corporation for an injury suffered during the officer's performance of official duties, curtailment of civil rights arising out of the officers performance, and the filing of a complaint against the officer which the filer knew was false when they filed the complaint. Recoverable damages would include both economic (verifiable losses) and noneconomic damages (subjective and unquantifiable losses).

There is no anticipated fiscal impact.
