LB210 would allow the part-time enrollment of students for all courses selected by the student. Every school board in Nebraska will need to establish policies and procedures to allow the participation of any student from a school which elects pursuant to §79-1601 not to meet accreditation or approval requirements in any extracurricular activities as defined in §79-2,126 to the same extent and subject to the same requirements, conditions, and procedures as students enrolled in the public school governed by such board, except that any school which elects pursuant to §79-1601 not to meet accreditation or approval requirements shall set the standards for satisfactory academic performance for students from the school to participate in extracurricular activities. School board policies and procedures adopted will not require any student participating in extracurricular activities to be enrolled in courses offered for credit by such school, will not allow any preference of a student for participation in an extracurricular activity based on such student's status as a full-time student in the school district, and may require any student participating in extracurricular activities to follow school policies that apply to other students when present on school grounds or at a school-sponsored activity or athletic event. Participation in extracurricular activities shall not entitle a student to transportation, except to and from practices and events to the same extent as public school students participating in such activities, or transportation reimbursement pursuant to §79-611.

Fiscal Impact should be minimal but will vary throughout the districts as they do not know how many part-time students will participate.
