Explanation of Estimate:

LB168 terminates authorization for the creation of sanitary and improvement districts (SID). Upon creation, each SID is required to file a record of their formation with the Secretary of State. The filing fee is \$30, plus \$10 for a certificate. An average of 17 SID's file formations resulting in an estimated revenue of \$680 each year, so a small revenue loss is anticipated as a result of this legislation. These fees would be deposited 60% to the General Fund and 40% to the Secretary of State Cash Fund. Due to the low number of formation filings, no changes in expenses are anticipated.
