Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

This bill would provide immunity from arrest and prosecution for witnesses and victims of violent crimes.

This bill could have an impact on both state prisons and county jails because the immunity provisions apply to crimes that are both felonies and misdemeanors.

Therefore, this bill has the potential to reduce both the state prison population and the county jail population. Felonies are served in state prisons and misdemeanors in county jails, if prison or jail time are imposed.

The Department of Correctional Services (DCS) states that the potential reduction of the state prison population is indeterminable.

The average daily prison population was 145% of design capacity as of December 2020, and the FY20 per diem cost for an individual inmate was \$10,180 per year, which includes DCS inmates in county jails.

Both the misdemeanor and felony penalties under this bill also carry the possibility of a fine being imposed. Any fines assessed pursuant to convictions will accrue to the county where the violation occurs to be used for the support of public schools. This bill has the possibility of reducing the amount of fines imposed, but any such reduction is unknown at this time.

The Supreme Court and the Nebraska State Patrol estimate no fiscal impact from this bill.
