This bill appropriates \$200,000 in General Funds to the Nebraska Commission on Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice (Crime Commission) for drug abuse prevention and education programs.

The Crime Commission is to award grants on a competitive basis to counties, cities, or non-profit organizations. The grant programs shall focus on elementary school-aged children. The programs shall aim at educating such children on the dangers of illegal drugs, and on preventing illegal drug use.

The Crime Commission states that it has grants and budget divisions that award funds, process payments, and evaluate outcomes for a number of state and federal grant programs. The agency notes that its current staff could administer this program.
